We confess our sin not in order for God to forgive us but because God has forgiven us in Christ. The call to confession, therefore, is a word of grace like the assurance of pardon, not an exercise that shames us into confession.

PRAYER OF CONFESSION

After the public confession below, you are encouraged to confess your sins silently to God.

We are not our own. We have been purchased by blood and made new, yet we cling to what is old. When your providence presents us with opportunity to share your goodness and love, your grace and mercy, we flee in fear and scoff in apathy. When we speak truth, we often fail to speak in love with a cool tongue. You are our Lord and Savior, teach us to walk in humility and meekness like your Son, Jesus. Amen.

The good news of the gospel is that in Christ we are forgiven! The announcement of this truth is one of the most beautiful moments in worship. Using scriptural words reinforces the truth that our assurance is based on God's words of promise, not merely on our own hopes and desires.
