The Heidelberg Catechism, Questions 46, 47, 49

Question: What do you mean by saying, "He ascended to heaven?"

- Answer: That Christ, while his disciples watched, was lifted up from the earth to heaven and will be there for our good until he comes again to judge the living and the dead.
- Question: But isn't Christ with us until the end of the world as he promised us?
- Answer: Christ is truly human and truly God. In his human nature Christ is not now on earth; but in his divinity, majesty, grace, and Spirit, he is not absent from us for a moment.
- Question: How does Christ's ascension to heaven benefit us?
- Answer: First, he pleads our cause in heaven in the presence of his Father. Second, we have our own flesh in heaven - a guarantee that Christ our head will take us, his members, to himself in heaven. Third, he sends his Spirit to us on earth as a further guarantee. By the Spirit's power we make the goal of our lives, not earthly things, but the things above where Christ is, sitting at God's right hand.
