*CALL TO WORSHIP

Psalm 103:1-6, 8, 14, 17-22 (ESV)

As God's Word calls us to worship, let's shout these words to one another recognizing that our worship is a response to God's gracious call.

- Leader: Bless the LORD, O my soul, and all that is within me, bless his holy name!
- People: **Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits, who forgives all your iniquity, who heals all your diseases, who redeems your life from the pit, who crowns you with steadfast love and mercy, who satisfies you with good so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's.**
- Leader: The LORD works righteousness and justice for all who are oppressed.
- People: **The LORD is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love. He will not always chide, nor will he keep his anger forever. For he knows our frame; he remembers that we are dust.**
- Leader: But the steadfast love of the LORD is from everlasting to everlasting on those who fear him, and his righteousness to children's children, to those who keep his covenant and remember to do his commandments.
- People: **The LORD has established his throne in the heavens, and his kingdom rules over all.**
- Leader: Bless the LORD, O you his angels, you mighty ones who do his word, obeying the voice of his word!
- People: **Bless the LORD, all his hosts, his ministers, who do his will!**
- ALL: **Bless the LORD, all his works, in all places of his dominion. Bless the LORD, O my soul!**
