Creation Focus: Water, Sky & Land

Dress Up Theme: Crazy Hair & Socks

Memory Verses (Older Kids memorize all; Younger Kids memorize **bold**):

Matthew 6:28-30

And why are you anxious about clothing? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin, yet I tell you, even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. **But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today is alive and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, will he not much more clothe you, O you of little faith.**

Questions:

- Where is your favorite place to go in all of God's Creation?
- How does knowing that God created spaces for his creatures help us love and trust him?
- How does knowing God made beautiful plants help us not to worry? (Matthew 6:28-30)
- Read John 14:1-3. Are you excited about the place that Jesus is preparing for everyone who believes in him? Why or why not?

Psalm 19:1, 4, 5

The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above proclaims his handiwork. Their voice goes out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world. In them he has set a tent for the sun, which comes out like a bridegroom leaving his chamber, and, like a strong man, runs its course with joy.

Questions:

- What is your favorite thing (moon, star, planet, etc.) in outer space?
- How do the heavens declare the glory of God? How can you declare God's glory too?
- Read Genesis 15:1-6. If you believe God like Abraham, then you are part of the descendants God promised Abraham. How does that make you feel?
- Read Revelation 22:1-5. In heaven there will be no need for the sun because Jesus will shine so bright. How can you spend forever with Jesus in heaven? Is that something that makes you excited? Why or why not?

Memory Verses (Older Kids memorize all; Younger Kids memorize **bold**):

Psalm 104:24, 25, 31, 33

O LORD, how manifold are your works! In wisdom have you made them all; the earth is full of your creatures. Here is the sea, great and wide, which teems with creatures innumerable, living things both small and great. May the glory of the LORD endure forever; may the LORD rejoice in his works. I will sing to the LORD as long as I live; I will sing praise to my God while I have being.

Questions:

- What is your favorite kind of bird, fish, or animal that God created?
- Read Isaiah 11:6-9. How is this picture of how things will be in heaven one day different from how things are in the world right now?
- Read John 1:29-34. Why is Jesus called the Lamb of God?
- Does knowing that Jesus takes away sin and bring peace help you love and trust him? Why or why not?

Game/Activity:

- Post a video of yourself singing a song from today's Facebook Live video
- Post a photo or video of your pets (or your favorite animals)
- **Animalphabet:** Have someone pick a letter of the alphabet then try to name as many animals as you can in 60 seconds that start with that letter.
If you're playing against other people, alternate giving answers. If someone repeats an answer, gives a wrong answer, or doesn't answer, they are out.
