*CALL TO WORSHIP

Ezekiel 36:22-27, 36, 38 (ESV)

As God's Word calls us to worship, let's shout these words to one another recognizing that our worship is a response to God's gracious call.

Leader:

"Therefore say to the house of Israel, Thus says the Lord GOD: It is not for your sake, O house of Israel, that I am about to act, but for the sake of my holy name, which you have profaned among the nations to which you came. And I will vindicate the holiness of my great name, which has been profaned among the nations, and which you have profaned

among them.

Response: I will take you from the nations and gather you from all the countries and bring you

into your own land. I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be clean from

all your uncleannesses, and from all your idols I will cleanse you.

Leader: And I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you.

Response: And I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh.

And I will put my Spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes and be

careful to obey my rules.

Leader: Then the nations that are left all around you shall know that I am the LORD; I have rebuilt

the ruined places and replanted that which was desolate. I am the LORD; I have spoken,

and I will do it.

ALL: Then they will know that I am the LORD."
